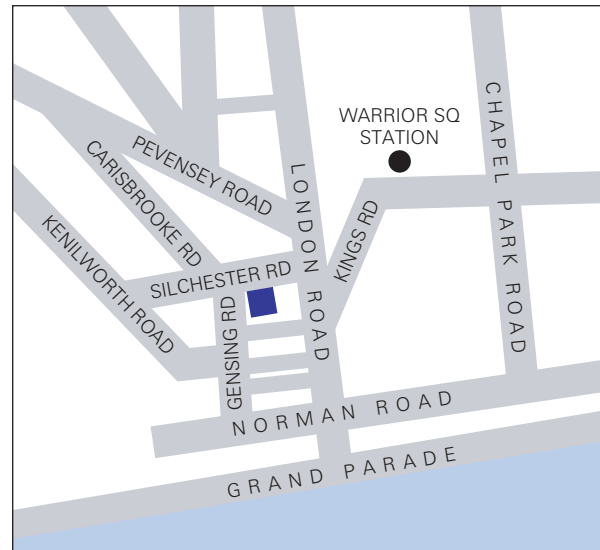


Silchester Mews is also the base for many other local organisations, including:

- **MACA (Mental After Care Association)** - Office base offering clients a variety of activities
- **KAMM (Kids and Muslim Mothers)** - Offers support and Arabic lessons to Muslim women and their children
- **HCAAT (Hastings College of Art & Technology)** - There are a variety of courses available here, most also supported with crèche facilities
- **CommIT Centre** - The Hastings commIT Centre offers various computer training courses, including Internet access
- **Sussex Careers** - The agency offers computer courses as well as career advice
- **Tomorrow's People** - Regular advice sessions, offering help to anyone looking for work
- **Gensing and Central St Leonards Community Forum** - the Forum is based here. Their aim is to give local residents the opportunity to influence how the Neighbourhood is improved, including spending the new Neighbourhood Renewal Funding. Any comments or points of view can be left here and passed onto the relevant people

Silchester Mews is a community resource centre in the heart of St Leonards.

There are rooms available for use by community groups, as well as a range of activities open to all local residents. The centre is also a resource for community groups, offering help and advice on funding, training, committee skills and signposting to other agencies.

### Ideas and suggestions

New ideas and suggestions are always welcome. Here are just a few of the groups and activities available:

- Under Ones Club - an informal group for those with children under one year
- Messy Play Club - open to all families who enjoy painting, craft projects or just making a mess
- Tuesday Club - this is a social group for those over 60. A range of activities are available, plus refreshments
- Asylum Seekers Drop-In - open to all asylum seekers and refugees. Support, practical help and basic English lessons available
- Healthy Living Centre - Silchester Mews is also part of this new exciting project for Hastings, offering a range of activities and services for those between 16 and 25

Silchester Mews has a range of space and resources available including:

#### Ground floor (fully accessible)

- Large meeting room - this can be used as a classroom, for meetings or group activities
- Crèche room - ideal for child based groups, but also crèches and art groups
- Specially built children's toilets
- 2 fully accessible toilets for adults, including baby-changing facilities
- Kitchen

#### First floor

- Small meeting room (max 10 people)
- Offices
- Toilet
- Small kitchen
