
Generally this has been Hastings Borough Council and associated departments but in some cases funding was sort from charitable trusts and statutory bodies such as English Heritage.

ON - GOING MAINTENANCE BY:

How the project is managed post completion. This is normally undertaken by Hastings Borough Council although work on private land has relied on the owners to adopt a sympathetic approach to the care of completed projects. This is evident at Trade Paints Garden where the completed project has actually been enhanced by the owners. Hastings Trust have two sites which receive regular maintenance these are St. James's Steps and the "Wild Corner" at Harold Road.



INTRODUCTION: PLEASE READ ME!

This guide has been designed primarily for public viewing and provides an insight into the many physical projects Hastings Trust has executed from it's founding and inauguration in 1990 to present day.

The project records should not be considered as individual case studies but as a comprehensive guide for one to browse. The information has been collated from the Trusts' own archives and all details presented are to the best of our knowledge. The reader must observe that some project staff assigned to specific projects were unavailable to input information in this document therefore some information scrutinised may contain minor inaccuracies.

The many photographs accompanying project records have been used to depict work being undertaken by staff and volunteers and provide an insight into the Trusts' activities. Detailed information relating to specific projects e.g. How did you do that ? can be given on request.



BROWSERS GUIDE

NAME / LOCATION

The name of the project and where it is situated.

COUNCIL WARD

The defined area within the borough relating to parish boundries and where you vote. Each ward has its own elected councillors.

START DATE

The time when the project was instigated and pursued. Not when work started on site.

PROJECT HOURS (DEVELOPMENT)

The time spent on research / development / phone calls / costing and scheduling / seeking funding / statutory permissions / land search / forming partnerships / finding skilled labour / volunteers.

PROJECT HOURS (ON SITE)

The time spent undertaking physical work to completion.

No. OF STAFF (PAID)

Members of staff e.g. Project Officers employed by Hastings Trust assigned to a project.

No. STAFF (VOLUNTEERS)

Persons whom have dedicated their services free of charge to assist in projects. The government scheme Community Action provided many participants in 1994/95. Some volunteers became employees and are still present at the Trust.

DEVELOPMENT COSTS

The cost of pursing an idea to fruition e.g. time spent researching / drawing plans / quantifying materials ect.

Many projects involved every member of staff to input and allocate time and labour.

MATERIALS COST

This information was difficult to quantify but figures relate to components that are necessary to complete projects e.g. bricks, stone, mortar, plants etc.

SUB- CONTRACT COSTS

The money spent on employing professional builders / painters and craftsmen on projects where work could not be undertaken by ourselves. e.g. large scale construction projects such as Provincial Passage where heavy plant was used to excavate road.

TOTAL

The combined cost of the project.

ESTIMATED COST

The cost of the project relating to the Compulsory Competitive Tendering Process. The cost that Hastings Borough Council would have to pay a professional contractor to undertake work to our specifications. This is generally a greater sum of money because contractors employ staff and charge rates of labour where as Hastings Trust can employ volunteers. This factor has always been exploited by the Trust to a great saving for local rate payers. Whilst operating it has never been our intention to deny work from self employed builders etc.. because without the Trust as initiators the work would never have been pursued by anyone else.

In fact the Trust has always compromised by employing professional contractors on many projects.
